Ms. Perricone stated that Board Member Slaton would be providing a cost on building the box for the Little Free Library.

She stated there could be a strong possibility for benches in the future. There was discussion of the painting chairs project and auctioning them off. She stated this could possibility be a project for next year. A mural of an umbrella was shared. All board members agreed on this mural, Ms. Perricone stated she would find building locations for this mural. It was discussed that board members could paint this mural themselves. There was discussion to move forward with this.

Ms. Perricone discussed the annual report that comes out every year for the Town, she would be requesting that the board be included in there.

- a) Ms. Ryan discussed she has been communicating with Cat White in the Communication Office. Ms. Ryan and Ms. Perricone met with them to discuss the update to the website. Some of copy needed for the website are: tree sweater page, art in schools (would like copy to show how the Town is collaborating with schools); Dane Martin's YouTube video on the loom weaving project; CVA (would like copy on this about the monthly art in Town Hall); Greenway Art Project; and Community Garden on Main Street - Ms. Perricone stated we do not have any affiliation with them and there was discussion on leaving them off the website. There was discussion on possibly including information on the website about murals. Ms. Ryan asked members to provide copy on the particular project they are working on. She stated if a

member is having trouble with copy, let her know, she would brainstorm together with them.

Ms. Ryan stated she is working on artists for the Sculpture Trail with Ms. White.

There was discussion on where to place the Sculpture Trail brochures throughout the Town.

Ms. Perricone stated Tiffany with Tiffany's Tea House would like a mural; this could face Clark Hipolito's mural. Council Member Casey and Ms. Perricone would be speaking to the Rotary Club and presenting to them about bringing up fundraising. There was mention of asking them to sponsor a sculpture.

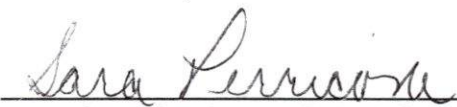

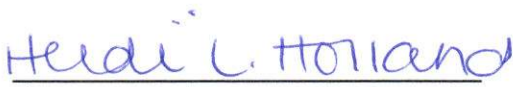
