The board again reviewed what the program should include based on the feedback Ms. Long had received from her fellow teachers. The board will continue its discussion at the June Board Meeting.

- a) Fire Department Mural (*This item was added to the agenda.*)

Mr. Sutphin shared details on this project. He stated with the passing of Jason Dean, Deputy Fire Chief, the Fire Department would like to have a line of duty memorial in his honor. He stated he would like to have a landscaped area with a flagpole. He has spoken with Mr. Hipolito and Lacey Crime. Ms. Crime has painted murals in Selma. He stated he had a zoom meeting with her to discuss this further.

In this mural, which will be on the admin side of the building, he would like to reflect the history of the Fire Department. His idea for the mural would include: 1947 engine, new engine, old fire house with Lucy (the fire dog), image of the last ride with Mr. Dean, new ladder truck, water tower, Willie Bridges, Station 2, 3 patches, and Special Ops. This should be completed in July. The funding for this comes from the Ransom on the Roof & other contributors. There will be plaques with the sponsors names on it.

Mr. Sutphin stated he would bring this idea before Council to receive their input. Ms. Perricone stated she would like to be at that meeting as well.

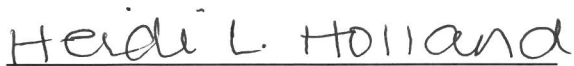
