location suggestion for each one. The sculptures selected for recommendation to Town Council were:

Recommended for Town Square:

- Wings, Key Winds, Double Purple Whisper Bench, Walking Watcher

Recommended for the Library:

- High Rise, Magic Man

Recommended for Horne Square:

- Oculi Aqua, Black Eyed Susan, Summertime Blues

Recommended for the Roundabout:

- Life Cycle

Recommended for the Community Center:

- Big Orange Stack

Recommended for Town Hall:

- Peaceful Passage, La Vie en Rose

Chosen as Alternates:

- City Limits, Flower Girl

After the motion was made and voted on to accept the nominations, Ms. Beard shared with the board the art sculptures that were not selected. The board members discussed these sculptures and voiced their opinions. The current sculptures are scheduled to be removed around May with the new installations in by Mid-June. It was stated the current sculptures do not have plaques with identifying information on them. 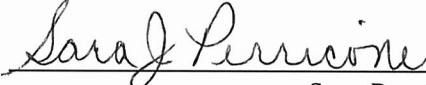

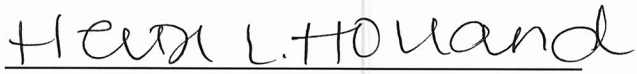
