1 CALL TO ORDER

- a) The meeting was called to order by Sara Perricone at 5:06 p.m.

2 APPROVAL OF MINUTES

4 OLD BUSINESS

- a) 2019-2020 Sculpture Trail Update
- People's Choice Awards
- Presenter:* Stacy Beard, Public Information Officer

One of the selected sculptures, Black Eyed Susan, was assigned to another town before we could secure it with a contract. The original plan was to place Black Eyed Susan in Horne Square with the thought of a flower theme in that location. Ms. Beard asked the artist if she had any other flower sculptures we could look at, the artist has not replied yet. The board looked at the other sculptures that were submitted to decide what to put in place of Black Eyed Susan. The two options the board discussed as replacements were the Flying Goldfish and Flower Girl. There was discussion of moving La Vie en Rose from Town Hall

to Horne Square to keep the flower theme. It was mentioned Flower Girl is not colorful enough or tall enough to use in the area needed to fill. There was a unanimous vote and it was decided to use the Flying Goldfish in place of the Black Eyed Susan sculpture in Horne Square. As far as placement for the fish, it was suggested since this sculpture moves with the wind, to place it in an open spot where the wind would reach it. It was suggested to put Summertime Blues on the Lombard Street side and Flying Goldfish on the other side. These are just proposed placements for the sculptures, the actual locations will not be determined until the sculptures arrive and it is determined which ones will work best in the areas.

It was asked if the sculptures will have plaques this year, Ms. Beard stated she is currently working on that as well as the QR codes to go with the videos.

Discussion began on the People's Choice Awards, Ms. Beard stated all the videos are completed. Survey Monkey will be used again this year for the voting. There was discussion on when and where to announce the winner. The winner has been announced in the past at an outdoor concert series and also a CVA Reception. It was stated the outdoor concert may not be ideal for the announcement, the CVA Reception would be a more appropriate event. The CVA Reception will be held May 9th from 6-7:30 p.m. There needs to be announcements made to get as many people to attend as possible. It was suggested to have the winner announced between 6:30-6:45 p.m. Ms. Beard stated she would reach out to the CVA and get this approved with them.

- b) Outdoor Student Public Art Update
 - Corinth-Holders Art Reception

Presenter(s): Sara Perricone, Board Chair & Stacy Beard, Public Information Officer

Ms. Beard stated that Sarah Jeffrey and her students are coming to Town Hall the morning of April 30th for a school field trip to view their fish. Some of the students were not able to come to the reception on April 4th, this gives the students that could not make the reception a chance to view their work. It was stated the plan is to have the fish stay on the Greenway for two years, however, we need to be prepared. If the fish do not make it that long there need to be process and procedure in place for the next iteration of this project. Ms. Beard mentioned these fish would be up for sale at the end of the two years, or when they are removed from the Greenway. If any Corinth Holders clubs or the life skills students/parents want to buy any of the fish, they would have the first chance to.

It was suggestion that the next time this project is repeated, to possibly let Corinth Holders students do 20 fish and maybe a Boy Scout group do 20. Instead of having one particular group do all of the fish, have it split up among several different groups.

5 NEW BUSINESS

- a) New Project

Presenter: Sara Perricone

Ms. Perricone presented a new project that she would like the board to consider. She mentioned the "Before I Die" project and the success of it. She stated she would like to have a similar project but have it titled "I Love Clayton because...". The project would be up for the year-long celebration of the Town's 150th. It was discussed instead of having a

box up like the previous design, to have a large 1, 5, and 0 to represent the 150th. The numbers would be approximately 8' tall and 4' wide, which would be the same height as the "Before I Die" project. It was discussed this proposed project should go in Horne Square. Mr. Hipolito discussed different options that he could do with this project such as building a base plate and anchoring the numbers down to that.

- b) Three-Dimensional Artwork Display Case

Mr. McFadden stated he would like to have a three dimensional case that would be able to display various art that is not able to hang on a wall, items such as jewelry, woodworking, etc. His vision is to have the case in the lobby of Town Hall, however with weddings and other events held there, it may be in the way from time to time. It was suggested for Mr. McFadden to speak with Adam Lindsay about this.

6 MEMBER COMMENTS

Ms. Murray asked if it was decided if there will be a one IP address rule for survey monkey for the People's Choice Awards. This would prevent one person from possibly voting for the same sculpture multiple times. A decision was never made on this. With the winner announcement approaching, Ms. Perricone suggested Ms. Helmer contact Ms. Beard to find out about the IP decision.
