c) People's Choice Award

Ms. Beard shared information regarding use of "Survey Monkey" this year versus paper ballots. Winner of the People's Choice Award will be announced at the first Town Square concert, scheduled for May 18, 2018.

Ms. Beard stated links and videos will be released first week of April. Additionally, Facebook, Twitter and Town Website will be utilized.

Ms. Beard shared copies of the Sculpture Brochure. Members of the board will take some of the brochures and place them in local business locations.

There was discussion regarding having schools participate in the voting process. Ms. Helmer will contact some of the local art teachers and see how they may be able to incorporate this into art class. Additionally, board members will reach out to Johnston County Art Council and ask them to share the link. Ms. Christie & Mr. Stojic offered to present to schools. Ms. Helmer will check to see if kids could vote in school on chrome books provided by the school.

There was discussion regarding the voting process. Voting deadline will be May 5, 2018. We will check with Mayor to see if he will be available to present winner with check.

Ms. Perricone talked about the watermelon sculpture and spoke about some of repairs that need to be completed. Ms. Beard shared additional information regarding history of sculpture and transport. She provided additional information regarding the owner having to evacuate due to a hurricane.

Discussion regarding voting process last year versus this year. This year we will not do brackets and this information will be shared via social media sources.

Ms. Perricone asked about application including request for taller/larger/whimsical pieces. Ms. Beard stated that this information has been included as well as stressing that installation of sculptures needs to be completed by the artist. Ms. Beard will email copy of Call to Artists to Board Members.
