Mr. Sutphin provided an update on the fire department apparatus service and hose testing. All testing has been completed and passed. The service and heavy inspections were completed and the fire department passed both inspections. On December 20, 2017, the NC Department of Insurance will conduct a 9-S state inspection. This inspection is done periodically to inspect and ensure proper records are being kept pertaining to structure fires. Any documents associated with grants will be inspected to ensure funds are being used properly. The 9-S inspection also includes the inspection of the current apparatus being used.

Mr. Sutphin stated evaluations would be completed by mid-December. A MAPS study salary evaluation was recently completed. Every employee at the fire station filled out a

questionnaire provided by the MAPS Group. After all of the questionnaires are received, the company will compile the results based on other fire stations in the area as well as town population and compare salaries. The results have not yet been shared with staff.
